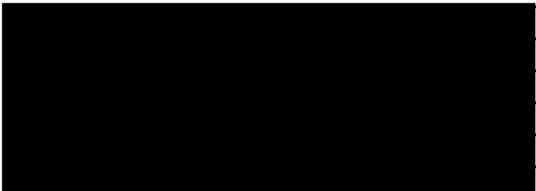

1. Was this chapter nominated, and does it qualify, for Distinguished Chapter Recognition for the award year?

NEACHMM was nominated for the Distinguished Chapter Recognition Award for the award year 2019.

2. Percentage of members that are also AHMP members?

As reported in the 2019 Chapter Annual Report, there were 63 dues paying members at the end of 2019. 41 members, or 65%, are also AHMP members. Additionally, there are three lifetime members.

3. Percentage of members with certifications other than the CHMM certification (CIH, CSP, CHP, PE, PG, etc.)?

NEACHMM members maintain the CHMM certification.

4. Number and level of cooperative relationships with other professional organizations, especially certifying organizations?

During 2019, NEACHMM partnered with two professional organizations:

- a) NEACHMM was approached by a local high school, Essex County Vocational Technical School, to assist with the final testing and certification of the school's HAZWOPER training program. NEACHMM partners with a local training vendor, Tiger Training, to complete the HAZWOPER final test and certification. This program has been very successful. NEACHMM has been providing this service annually, and at no cost, to the school.
- b) In April 2019, NEACHMM partnered with AHMP for the 2019 Boston Site Characterization Workshop.

5. Number and variety of professional development and education programs for members and prospective members?

During 2019, NEACHMM provided seven professional development and education programs for members and prospective members:

- a) *AHMP 2019 Boston Conference* – In April 2019, NEACHMM partnered with AHMP for the 2019 Boston Site Characterization Workshop.


- b) *TEI Young Professionals* – In April 2019, NEACHMM’s President, Jo-Ann Ranslow presented to Triumvirate Environmental Inc’s (TEI) Young Professionals on NEACHMM and the professional benefits of joining the organization.



- c) *M2D2 Tour* – In May 2019, NEACHMM coordinated a tour of the UMass Lowell Massachusetts Medical Device Development (M2D2) Program. The tour was open to members and prospective members.

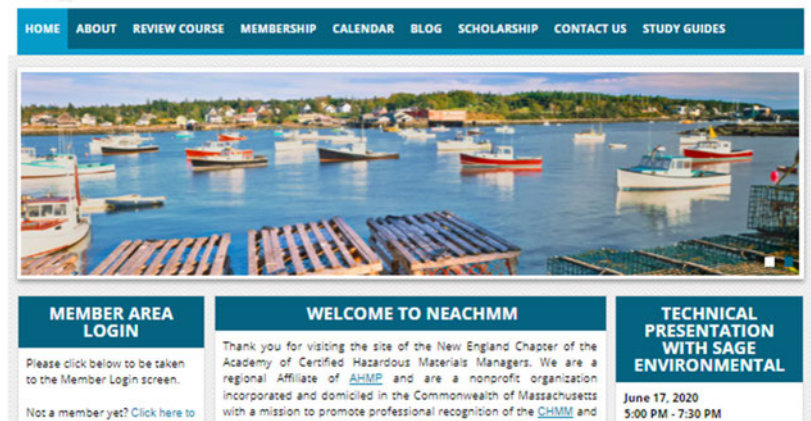

6. Number and scope of successful promotional (visibility) activities related to EHS&S professions, professional certifications, the chapter, and the AHMP?

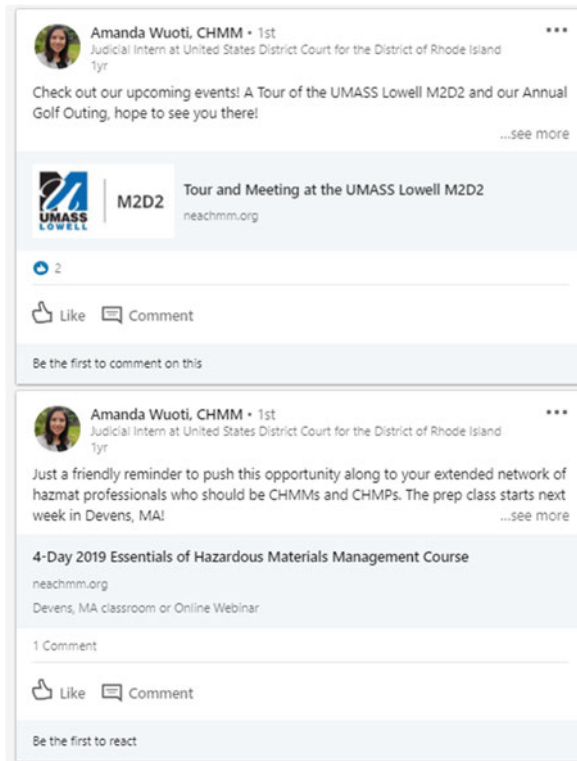
NEACHMM uses a variety of method to promote the Chapter, AHMP, and Chapter activities to members and prospective members. Specific examples are as follows:

8. Chapter's modes, creativity, and success at communicating with members and the public?

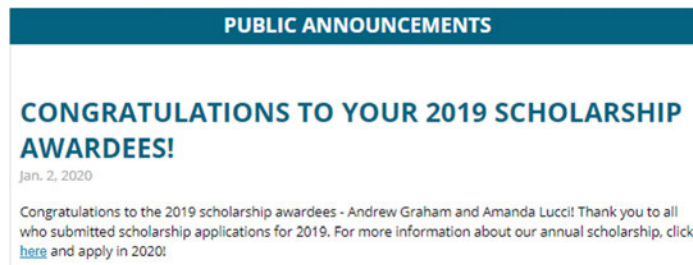
NEACHMM uses a variety of method to communicate with members and the public. Examples of communication methods include the following:

9. Community service and education?

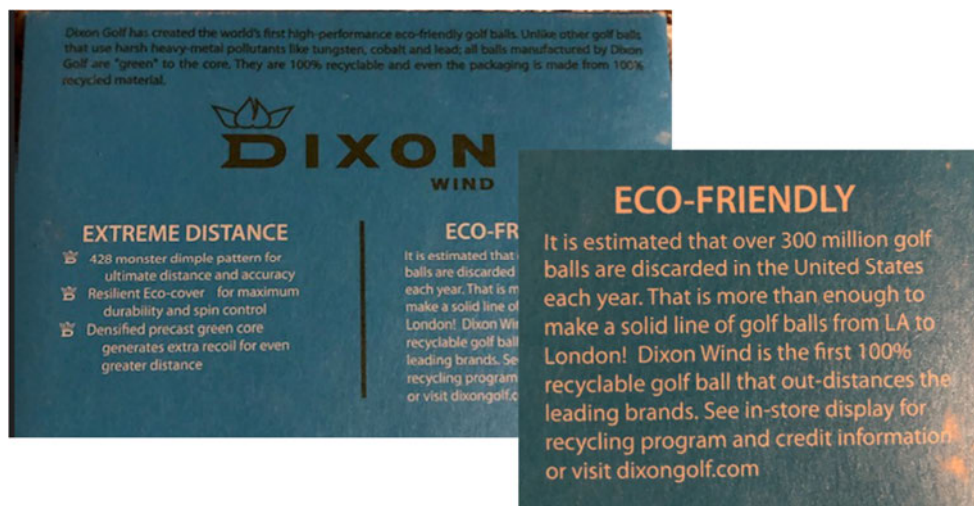
During 2019, NEACHMM completed the following community service and education activities:

- b) NEACHMM provided \$1,000 scholarships to two college students studying a major leading to a career in the EHS&S, or related, industry and/or family members or friends of Chapter members. The scholarships are funded with money from the Annual Golf Tournament.
